



Private developers will build 43 hospitals, clinics and surgeries in the next years

Private developers in the medical system will build or modernize, in the next years, 43 hospitals, clinics and surgeries, according to a market report carried out by **IBC Focus** Company. Bucharest and Sibiu are the performers of the investment chapter. These 2 locations will have the most new medical units.

The market report was conducted by **IBC Focus**, a company specialized in monitoring the construction market in Romania. The report reveals that the Romanian capital is the city with the most private investment in healthcare, as at least 6 new medical units are to be built here.

Bucharest leads also at the number of beds available in the Romanian private hospitals: in the next years there will be over 700 beds available in 4 new private hospitals. Also, in Sibiu there will be 5 new medical units built and in Brasov – 3. The **Hospitals and Clinics Report** contains complete information on 112 medical units in project phase or under construction and rehabilitation.

Healthcare Minister announced in May that, in the next 4 years, there will be 32 public hospitals built, with a total investment worth more than 2.7 billion Euros.
